

Circus City Speedway 2022 Rules

Track and Pit Rules

- 1. Pit Vehicles.** Indiana State Law requires all ATV riders under the age of 18 to wear a DOT approved helmet at all times. Only one rider for single seat ATV's. Golf carts may carry up to 4 people or a capacity that is deemed "safe" by CCS officials. No pit vehicles on the track at any time.
- 2. Pit Speed.** No speeding in the pits. All cars and pit vehicles must maintain a consistent and safe speed. No swerving, wheelies, or erratic driving. No exceptions!
- 3. Pit Violations.** Violations for pit vehicle rules can result in loss of privileges and/or suspension. Warnings will be limited. Be safe, and follow the rules!
- 4. Pit Spots.** Reserved pit spots will be available to purchase for the entire season. Reserved pit spots will be guaranteed until 5:00pm on race day. After 5:00pm, reserved pit spots will become available on a first come, first serve basis.
- 5. Barricades.** Barricades have been set behind the pit fence. All drivers, crew members, and fans must remain behind the barricades while under race conditions. Violations can result in disqualification or suspension. Be safe, and follow the rules!
- 6. Radio Communication.** One way radio communication between race control and the driver is mandatory. Radio communication between the pit crew and driver is prohibited.
- 7. Exiting the Track.** Once a car exits the racing surface it may not re-enter. The only exception is in the event of an altercation prior to the original green flag at race director's discretion. Maintain a safe and consistent speed while driving through the pit area.
- 8. Red Flags.** Red flags are closed unless stated otherwise.
- 9. Scoring Tower.** Do not enter the scoring tower unless invited. If you have an issue with scoring or any incident within the facility, please find a Circus City Speedway official. If you enter the scoring tower uninvited, you or your team will be disqualified for the night.
